Please present your requisition and BC CareCard upon arrival.

To the patient - preparation for your mammography examination

Your doctor has requested a mammogram which is a special x-ray of your breast(s). Modern mammography equipment is designed especially for this examination and produces only a minimum of radiation exposure. The examination is performed by specially trained technologists and takes approximately 15 minutes. During the examination your breasts will be moderately compressed to provide the best image.

Please refrain from applying any perfume, deodorant or powder on the day of the examination as it will prevent an optimal study.

After your mammography appointment

A radiologist will interpret the images and send a report to your doctor or specialist. Your doctor or specialist will discuss the results of the exam with you.
